

Responding to Incidents, Disclosures, and Suspicions of Child Abuse – Four Critical Actions

You Must Take Action

As a volunteer / staff member in your organisation you play a critical role protecting children and young people. You must follow the four actions below.

1 Responding

If a child / student is at risk of immediate harm you must ensure their safety by:

- Separating alleged victims and others involved
- Administering first aid
- Calling 000 for urgent medical and/or police assistance to respond to immediate health or safety concerns
- Identifying a contact person at for future liaison with Police.

If there is no immediate harm go to Action 2

2 Reporting

Any incident must be documented on the Child Abuse Incident Report Form

Where does the source of suspected abuse come from?

Within the family or community

Report to *Strong Families Safe Kids* Advice and Referral Line **within 24 hours**, Report to your local police and internally to the Deputy Principal.

Within the organisation

Report to the police or to *Strong Families Safe Kids* Advice and Referral Line **within 24 hours**. You must also report internally to the Deputy Principal who then needs to report to Human resources, Principal, the Board and the Australian Childhood Foundation.

3 Contacting

You must consult with *Strong Families Safe Kids* Advice and Referral Line or local police to determine the information that can be shared with parents / carers. The School will be guided by Tasmania Police regarding the process of investigating allegations of abuse.

This can include:

- Not to contact the parents / carers in circumstances where they have alleged to have engaged in the abuse or the child is a mature minor and does not wish their parent/carer to be contacted.
- To contact the parents / carers and provide agreed information as soon as possible.

4 Supporting

Your organisation should provide support for children impacted by abuse which could include: the development of a safety plan, direct support and/or a referral to wellbeing professionals.
